ULTRA ELECTRONICS LTD, PMES – RELOCATION TO NEW FACILITY

EARTH CUTTING CEREMONY ON MONDAY 14TH JANUARY 2008

TOWERS BUSINESS PARK, RUGELEY

- The sale of existing sites has paved the way for Ultra to place a prestigious £5.5 million design and build contract to construct a new purpose built facility on a 4.5 acre site at Towers Business Park, Rugeley.
- An earth cutting ceremony on Monday 14th January 2008 signalled the start of this exciting new development for Ultra Electronics PMES.
- The construction of the facility will be undertaken by TS Contracts Ltd and project managed will be through King Sturge LLP.
- The contract with TS contracts is to construct a modern curved roof structure complete with 2-storey offices and state of the art development and operational facilities. The building will cover 50,000sq.ft. and the site will incorporate extensive external areas including car parking, landscaping, test huts, fencing and security provisions.
- The construction contract of the new facility will last for approximately 38 weeks with completion scheduled for early in the last quarter of 2008.
- The relocation of the business to the new Towers facility is scheduled to occur during the first quarter of 2009, at which point PMES will vacate its existing Armitage Road site in Rugeley where the business was founded over 60 years ago.
- In preparation for this move to Towers, all sensors based development and production from the Fallow Park, Hednesford site will be relocated to our Armitage Road site during the first and second quarter of 2008.
